The City of La Crosse is seeking a highly qualified candidate to administer the long and short range planning programs as well as the economic development functions of the City. Position prepares, recommends and assists in the development and implementation of the City's Comprehensive Plan Elements, manages development review, ordinance writing and implementation, neighborhood and downtown revitalization efforts and subdivision review.

The selected candidate must possess a Masters Degree in Urban Planning, Urban and Regional Planning or related field. Candidate shall have eight years of progressively responsible experience in municipal or county planning, or any combination of experience that provides equivalent knowledge/skills/abilities. Position requires excellent oral and written communication skills. Strong computer skills in Microsoft Office are essential. This is a professional, exempt position with a starting annual salary of \$56,374 - \$64,837; depending on qualifications.

The City offers an excellent benefit package including medical benefit plan, Wisconsin Retirement Plan, deferred compensation, life insurance, income continuation insurance, voluntary dental plan, paid holidays, vacations and sick leave.
