GIS Coordinator, Web Developer

ORGANIZATION: The Southwestern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SWWRPC) is an area wide planning and development agency. Commission offices are located on the campus of the University of Wisconsin-Platteville. Since the organization's conception over thirty years ago, numerous young professionals have participated in SWWRPC's internship program and moved on to achieve success.

DESCRIPTION: SWWRPC seeks a qualified individual to lead the development and implementation of our GIS and related web-based applications. Duties include designing and maintaining spatial data layers and associated databases, data conversion, recommending workflows to create and maintain spatial data, and conducting land use and planning-related spatial analysis. GIS Coordinator will act as a major participant in the development and implementation of standards. Responsibilities involve assisting in capacity planning for data storage, processing and networking impact of GIS applications. Applicants will also be responsible for website maintenance and possibly web development, depending upon qualifications.

QUALIFICATIONS: Qualified candidates will have a B.S. Degree in GIS or a Degree in Geography, Land Use Planning or related field, with an emphasis in GIS. A GIS Certification with work experience may also be considered. Extensive knowledge of ESRI products is required. Knowledge of GIS planning applications and analysis is preferred. Web-development skills are also preferred.

LOCATION: Platteville is located 60 miles southwest of Madison, Wisconsin with a population of approximately 10,000. The city, nestled among rolling hills and surrounded by beautiful farm country, is home to the University of Wisconsin-Platteville. Platteville offers extensive recreation and arts programs, ranging from soccer to museums, art galleries to flag football, and dozens of activities in between. The University presents numerous artistic and athletic endeavors for the public's enjoyment, often for free or at prices far less than in larger cities.

AVAILABILITY: This position is a full-time, limited-term position based on the length of the project. In this case, the project is expected take 12 months to complete; however; additional contracts are possible.

COMPENSATION: SWWRPC offers a competitive salary.
